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Practicalities:

Take an Intercity train (ending in 'Aarhus', 'Aalborg', 'Lindholm', 'Esbjerg', 'Sønderborg', 'Struer' and maybe more places) to Nyborg, departing from Copenhagen Airport via Copenhagen Central Station ('Hovedbanegården') or directly from Copenhagen Central Station (twice an hour, minutes 00 and 30). Do NOT get on an Express ('Lyntog') train (every hour, minutes 50): it does *not* stop in Nyborg. If, by mistake, you actually do get on an Express train, get out the first (and only time) time it stops ('Høje Tåstrup') before Odense and get on the next, first and best Intercity going West. If you have not already purchased a ticket, you can do so while waiting for your luggage upon arrival in the airport. You do not have to have a seat reservation and your ticket (but not a seat reservation) is valid also for trains leaving earlier or later than the one for which you might have made a reservation.

Well off the train and on the platform in Nyborg: go downstairs. Look for signs saying 'Sti til strandhoteller' if you want 15 minutes of nice walk. When the small path ('sti') ends in a real road, turn right and you face the waterfront. Walk towards the water, cross a bridge over a highway, and some 50 meters before you walk into the water and the road makes a right turn, you turn left - and you are there. Don't turn right: it is a much bigger but not equally nice hotel.

If you do not want to walk, take a taxi.

Going back to Copenhagen Airport: Same procedure, just going back East. Trains twice an hour. But let us make sure that you get that journey right when you are here. The reception, no doubt, will have all information needed. But count on spending up to 2 hours and maybe a little more on the trip to the airport. For most flights, check in 60 minutes before departure is fine. For overseas flights, be prepared to be told to check in 120 minutes before departure.
